

THE CHEESE HOUSE & THE CYDER HOUSE AT WICK FARM, LACOCK

SELF-CATERING ACCESS STATEMENT

Introduction

This Grade I listed farm building, formerly used for making cider and cheese has been converted into two self catering cottages, opening in 1994.

The building is 16 metres long.

The houses are approached by driving along the "cottage driveway", there is parking for six cars on a gravel surface.

Four steps (26cm x 2, 23cm and 10cm) with handrail each side lead to the upper garden where there is a lawn with picnic bench for the Cyder House. A two seater seat is on the lawn of the Cheese House. The path is flagstones. A second set of four steps (26cm x 3 and 23cm x 1) again with handrails each side down to the lower level.

To the right a flagstone path leads to the front door of the Cheese House, a lawn area with hedging and picnic bench. To the left of the steps is flagstone path to the Cyder House front door, front doorstep of Cheese House 13cm, front doorstep of Cyder House 10cm.

Pre-Arrival
